

Privacy Policy

1. When signing up for an account at Pixxir, you will be asked to fill out some personal information. Your personal details, including your password, address and contact information, will never be disclosed to third parties. The personal information you enter when you sign up is solely to provide us with sufficient information to carry out our services.
2. When visiting the Pixxir website, certain data may be collected to allow us to improve our services. Such data includes, but is not limited to, browser information, screen resolution and Java/Flash compatibility. This collected data will not be disclosed to third parties.
3. Payments are made via either PayPal (where payments can be executed with credit cards or PayPal accounts) or iDeal. All transactions are executed on a secured server that carries an SSL-certificate.
4. We understand that questions about your privacy may arise. If you are concerned about your privacy, if you suspect a possible breach, or if you want general information concerning the protection of your details, please do not hesitate to contact us via techsupport@pixxir.com. 5. You can sign up for the Pixxir newsletter, but this is always your own choice. E-mail notifications regarding the approval or rejection of files are turned on by default, enrollment to the newsletter is not. You can change these preferences by going to *My Account – Edit my profile*.
